Eligibility criteria to become a Chartered Director

To register for the Professional Review Process leading to Chartered Director accreditation (CDir) you must be:

- A full Member of the Institute of Directors in Ireland.
- Have passed the IoD Certificate and Diploma examinations in Company Direction.
- A member of an autonomous and formally constituted board (or equivalent) comprising at least three directors (executive and non-executive) who meet a minimum of four times per year.
- Have a minimum of three years' experience as a director.
- Your organisation needs to have a minimum turnover of €300,000.
- Your organisation needs to have a minimum of five employees excluding the directors.

The maximum time for applying to become a Chartered Director, having passed the Certificate and Diploma in Company Direction, is ten years. Roles or experience that exceed ten years from the point of application will not be accepted. The role(s) that you put forward should include at least one that has been held in the last five years.
